CONDITIONS OF SALE

FIRST The highest approved bidder shall be the purchaser. No bidding to be retracted. Each purchaser shall give up his (or her) name and address when asked for. Should any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute shall be put up again and resold; and the Auctioneers reserve to themselves the right of refusing any person's bid, and shall be the sole Arbitrators on any matter in dispute during the sale. The vendor also reserves the right to bid by his agent.

SECOND The full purchase money for each lot shall be paid for at the fall of the hammer (if required) or directly after the close of sale. Each and every lot shall immediately on the fall of the hammer be considered as delivered, and shall remain in every respect at the absolute risk of the respective purchaser or purchasers thereof, and shall be removed from the place of sale at the purchaser's expense, and taken with all faults and errors of description, the Auctioneers not being answerable for the authenticity, genuineness, or completeness of any lot.
